MINUTES OF MEETING MEADOW VIEW AT TWIN CREEKS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT

The regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Meadow View at Twin Creeks Community Development District was held on Thursday, September 20, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. at the offices of Governmental Management Services, 475 West Town Place, Suite 114, St. Augustine, Florida 32092.

The following is a summary of the discussions and actions taken at the September 20, 2018 meeting. A copy of the proceedings can be obtained by contacting the District Manager.

FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS Call to Order

Mr. Oliver called the meeting to order.

SECOND ORDER OF BUSINESS Public Comment

There were no audience members in attendance.

THIRD ORDER OF BUSINESS Affidavit of Publication

A copy of the affidavit of publication of notices for the public hearing on assessments was included in the agenda package.

FOURTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Public Hearing on Imposition of Special Assessments

On MOTION by Mr. Parker seconded by Mr. Bishop with all in favor the public hearing was opened.

Mr. Earlywine stated there are essentially two things that we're doing today; first we're going to hold the public hearing for the purpose of levying special assessments in connection with the new bond issuance. The second thing we're going to do is authorize the issuance of the bonds. We have a new product type, which is the 73' premium and we need to assign an EAU value to that. There's also a discrepancy that we want to clarify and clean up. We want to make it clear that you can pay off B debt and then create a new assessment area on unplatted lands within the District and assign new debt to that area and that concept wasn't in the prior version of the methodology.

A. Consideration of Supplemental Engineer's Report

Mr. Lockwood stated Phase 3A has been added to the report and we also decided that there were going to be bonds for 2018 and 2019. The 2018 project will cover phase two and the townhomes. The 2019 bonds will cover phase 3A. There have also been some minor changes based on staff comments.

Mr. Earlywine asked is it your opinion that the costs of the project are fair, reasonable and consistent with market conditions?

Mr. Lockwood responded the opinion of probable costs that I have in the engineer's report are fair based on market conditions.

Mr. Earlywine asked and it's also your opinion that the plan is feasible?

Mr. Lockwood responded yes I see no impediment.

B. Consideration of Assessment Methodology Reports

- 1. First Amendment to the Supplemental Report for the Series 2018A-1 and A-2 Special Revenue Bonds
- 2. Second Amendment to the Supplemental Report for the Series 2018A-1 and A-2 Special Revenue Bonds for the Series 2019 Project
- 3. Second Revised Master Special Assessment Methodology Report
- 4. Amended Supplemental Report for the Series 2016B Special Revenue Bonds

Mr. Perry stated the reports that you have before you are consistent with what's happened with the engineer's report. Originally we contemplated only issuing one bond for phases two, the townhomes and 3A so what we've done now with the first amendment to the supplemental report is to include the 2018 bonds that are going to be secured by phase two and the townhomes. The second amendment to the supplemental report is anticipating bonds that are going to be issued in 2019 and that's going to be related to phase 3A. In addition to that we have a second revised master special assessment methodology report and again, that recognizes moving forward with two bond issues. Also included in that is the new 73' premium product. Finally, you have an amended supplemental report for the series 2016B bonds. Again, that recognizes the two bond issues that are going to occur and the pay downs associated with each phase of those bonds.

Mr. Earlywine asked is it your opinion that there is sufficient benefit from the project showed by the assessment levels?

Mr. Perry responded there is.

Mr. Earlywine asked and it's also your opinion that they are fairly and reasonably allocated based on the ERU factor set forth in the tables?

Mr. Perry responded they are.

C. Consideration of Resolution 2018-07, Equalizing and Levying Special Assessments

Mr. Earlywine stated this resolution essentially adopts those reports and would finally levy and impose your master special assessment liens. When we go to issue bonds we will have supplemental resolutions that will have specific pricing for the 2018 and 2019 bonds.

On MOTION by Mr. Parker seconded by Mr. Kovacic with all in favor Resolution 2018-07 was approved with the Chairman authorized to execute.

On MOTION by Mr. Bishop seconded by Mr. Blanchard with all in favor the public hearing was closed.

D. Consideration of Resolution 2018-08, Delegating Award of Bonds

- 1. Form of Third Supplemental Indenture
- 2. Form of Fourth Supplemental Indenture

- 3. Form of Bond Purchase Contract

Mr. Earlywine stated this resolution authorizes the issuance of the not to exceed \$30 million special assessment bonds and authorizes MBS to move forward with negotiating the sale of the bonds.

On MOTION by Mr. Parker seconded by Mr. Bishop with all in favor Resolution 2018-08 was approved.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Approval of Minutes of the August 16, 2018 Meeting

There were no comments on the minutes.

On MOTION by Mr. Kovacic seconded by Mr. Blanchard with all in favor the minutes of the August 16, 2018 meeting were approved.

SIXTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Ratification of Agreements with ECS Florida, LLC

- A. Geotechnical Exploration and Engineering Services
- **B.** Construction Materials Testing Services Townhomes
- C. Construction Materials Testing Services Phase 2

Mr. Kovacic stated these proposals have been reviewed in great detail and discussed with our District Engineer. These are the services that have to happen in order to proceed with engineering design for phase 3A.

On MOTION by Mr. Kovacic seconded by Mr. Parker with all in favor the agreements with ECS, Florida, LLC were ratified.

SEVENTH ORDER OF BUSIENSS Status Update on Amenity Center Opening

Mr. Parker stated as of now the amenity center is on schedule to open in late January. That is not a definite date but the contractors are doing a great job so my projection stands at this time.

EIGHTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Discussion of Landscape Maintenance Scope

Mr. Oliver stated Riverside Management Services has agreed to assist with preparing the scope and we will also consult with the current landscaper. In the meantime, the current landscape maintainer will continue to provide services on a month-to-month basis.

NINTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Consideration of Construction Related Matters

A. Consideration of Change Order for Hughes Brothers Contract / Additional Site Work

Mr. Earlywine stated we have had a contract in place with Hughes Brothers and they did a lot of our site work for phase one. This is a change order to that contract which would authorize some additional site work to the upcoming phases. It's about \$1.5 million and then we also have our cost share agreement that goes with it. If you recall with that cost share agreement, if there are any private items the developer pays for those. We are going to talk about doing a larger RFP for that work but we don't want to delay the site work.

B. Consideration of Addendum to Cost Share Agreement with Heartwood 23, LLC

On MOTION by Mr. Kovacic seconded by Mr. Lyman with all in favor the Hughes Brothers change order and cost share agreement with Heartwood 23, LLC for additional site work were approved.

C. Consideration of RFP for Phase 2 / Townhome Work

Mr. Earlywine stated we are doing two RFPs for phase two and the townhomes. You all will be serving as the evaluation committee for purposes of the RFP like we've done in the past.

The Board and staff discussed specifics of the RFP.

On MOTION by Mr. Lyman seconded by Mr. Kovacic with all in favor RFPs for phase two / townhome site work were approved in substantial form.

TENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Consideration of Proposal from VGlobalTech for ADA Website Accessibility

Mr. Oliver stated as units of government in Florida, statutes require that CDDs maintain websites to post certain official documents. This District meets those requirements. Recently there have been lawsuits filed against CDDs in South and Central Florida regarding accessibility obstacles to those websites by persons who are visually impaired. In response to

that, we've been working with the counsel and the District's insurance company to make these websites compliant. We're planning the needed adjustments for mitigating the exposure to litigation and remedial action to remain compliant in the future. We've gotten some proposals and will keep you posted on this process.

ELEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Consideration of Matters Regarding Dock Easement

Mr. Oliver requested the Board appoint Ernesto Torres to serve as Assistant Secretary, which would allow him to execute documents on behalf of the District.

C. District Manager – Presentation of Operations & Maintenance Assessment Methodology Report

Mr. Perry stated most districts allocate assessments based upon the ERU factor associated with the bonds that have been issued. This report pretty much follows that except for 73' premium lots. The ERU factor on that is just a little bit higher than a 73' lot and that's because in regards to the issuance of the bonds the ERU factor is 1.39 we used for 73' premiums and a lot of that is associated with infrastructure that is going to be turned over to various facilities so the incremental increase for just a 73' lot is going to be related to our gate that is going to be installed related to that 73' premium development area.

Mr. Earlywine stated I think there was some interest in having an O&M assessment in place so what we could do is go through an assessment hearing and adopt a cap rate assessment amount which would set forth what these amounts are and going forward we would not need future public hearings if we stay within those numbers.

Mr. Parker stated I think we should do that.

On MOTION by Mr. Parker seconded by Mr. Kovacic with all in favor to authorize staff to move forward with O&M assessment proceedings at the October meeting was approved.

FOURTEENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS Financial Reports

Understanding Your Natural Gas Charges

BTU - British thermal unit - a unit of heat measurement.

Budget Billing - Optional plan lakes the highs and lows out of monthly natural gas bills. This "leveling" billing plan averages your last 12 monthly billing periods so you can pay about the same amount for your service each month.

Buried Piping Notification - Fectoral regulations require that Peoples Gas notify our customers who own buried piping of the following: 1) When excavating near buried gas piping, the piping should be located in advance; 2) The gas supplier does not own or maintain the customer's buried piping; 3) Buried piping that is not maintained may be subject to corrosion and/or leakage. Buried piping should be inspected periodically and any unsafe conditions repaired. Licensed plumbers, heating and air conditioning contractors, or Peoples Gas can conduct inspections.

Conversion Factor - This factor is used to adjust for variations from standard delivery pressure and standard delivery temperature where applicable

Customer Charge - A fixed monthly amount to cover the cost of providing gas service. This charge is billed monthly regardless if any gas is used.

Distribution Charge - Covers the costs of moving gas from its source to your premise, other than the cost of gas itself.

Estimated — If Peoples Cas was unable to read your gas meler, "ESTIMATED" will appear. Your gas use has been estimated based on previous usage. The meter is scheduled to be read next month, and any difference between the estimate and actual use will be adjusted accordingly.

Florida Gross Receipts Tax - A lax is imposed on gross receipts from utility services that are delivered to retail customers in Florida, in accordance with Chapter 203 of the Florida Statutes. The tax is levied on utility companies, which collect the tax from all customers, unless exempt, and remit to the state.

Florida State Tax - A privilege lax imposed on every person who engages in the business of selling or renting langible personal properly at retail in the state, in accordance with Chapter 2·12 of the Florida Statutes.

Franchise Fee - A fee levied by a municipality for the right to utilize public property for the purpose of providing gas service. Like taxes, the fee is collected by Pooples Gas and is paid to the municipality. Late Payment Charge - The late payment charge is 1.5% of the past due amount.

Main Extension Charge - A flat monthly tee to recover the cost of extending mains to a particular area when the cost exceeds the maximum allowable construction cost.

Measured Volume - Your natural gas usage in CCF (one hundred cubic feet) or MCF (one thousand cubic feet). These are the standard units of gas measurement.

Municipal Public Service Tax - In addition to the Franchise Fee, many municipalities levy a lax on the gas you use. It is collected by Peoples Gas and paid to the municipality.

■GA Charge - Purchased Gas Adjustment - The cust of gas purchased for you by Peoples Gas and delivered to your premises.

Rate Schedule: The amount (rate) you pay depends on your customer category. The cost of providing service varies with the customer group.

Share - A program co-sponsored by Peoples Gas and the Salvation Army where customers can help pay the energy bills of customers in need. A one-time contribution can be made, or your monthly elected contribution will appear on your bill. Your contribution is tax deductible and is matched by Peoples Gas.

Swing Charge - Covers the costs that are incurred by Peoples Gas to balance the difference between a customer's actual daily usage and the gas delivered by your gas supplier (pool manager).

Therm - A unit of beat equat to one hundred thousand (100,000) PHEs

Total Amount Due - This month's charges will be past due after the date shown. THIS DATE DOES NOT EXTEND THE DATE ON ANY PREVIOUS BALANCE. It is important that you pay your bill before this date in order to avoid interruption of service.

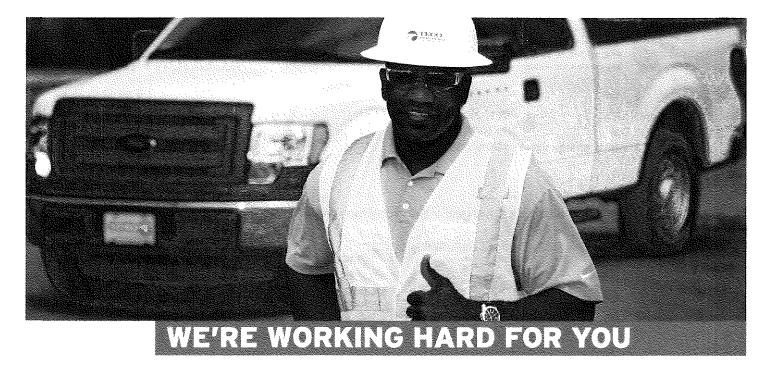
